






Multi-level framework



Macro level: why countries want to join




Micro level: the business case

Issues to consider: summary

- Myriads of issues to consider, on three different levels
- Interdependent levels, all with path dependencies and inertia
 - Perceptions depend on actions of micro/macro actors
 - Micro actors actions depend on macro frame and acceptance
 - Macro actors actions depend on perceptions
- Possibility for veto on each of the levels
- Successful policies must acknowledge all three levels
